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LOCATION OF UNIT: The Model 8605WC Barrier Free Emergency Shower & Eye/Face Wash Booth should be installed in close proximity to potential accident areas. It should be clearly identified free from obstructions and easy to access.

SUPPLY LINE: The minimum recommended line size is 1" IPS with 30-90 psi (2-6 ATM) flowing pressure. Where sediment or mineral content is a problem, an inlet filter is recommended.

PLUMBING CONNECTIONS: Inlet supply is female 1" IPS. Waste outlet is 3" IC (Inside caulk).



	PROBLEM	REPAIR CHECKLIST			
1.	No flow.	 Check the main shut-off valve. 			
2.	Insufficient water flow.	 Verify minimum 30 psi (2 ATM) flowing supply line pressure. 			
3.	Insufficient water flow. On eyewash, however, shower is sufficient.	3. a. Probable clogging of flow control due to inadequate line flushing. Unscrew eye/face wash head and remove the four screws to disassemble the head. Clean flow control and reassemble head. See SP65 Installation Drawing for details.			
4.	Insufficient water flow at the showerhead, however, eyewash is sufficient.	 Probable clogging of flow control inside showerhead. Unscrew showerhead off of elbow and clean rubber flow control. 			
5.	Eyewash stream does not meet desired eye level.	 Possible blocked flow control, see above solution. Possible non- leveled eyewash assembly. 			
6.	Water does not drain properly.	 Check the main waste line of your building to see if it does handle the capacity required for the entire drainage system.


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



- TO COMPLY WITH ANSI Z358.1-2014 FOR EMERGENCY EYEWASH OR EYE/FACE WASH: EYEWASH OR EYE/FACE WASH SHALL BE POSITIONED SUCH THAT FLUSHING FLUID PATTERN IS NOT LESS THAN 33" (838mm), NO GREATER THAN 53" (1346mm) FROM SURFACE ON WHICH USER STANDS, AND 6.0" (153mm) MINIMUM FROM WALL OR NEAREST OBSTRUCTION.
- 3 SHOWER SHALL BE POSITIONED SUCH THAT SHOWER HEAD IS NOT LESS THAN 82" (2083mm) OR GREATER THAN 96" (2438mm) FROM SURFACE ON WHICH USER STANDS.
- 4. SHOWER SPRAY PATTERN SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM DIAMETER OF 20" (508mm) AT 60" (1524mm) ABOVE SURFACE ON WHICH USER STANDS. CENTER OF SPRAY PATTERN SHALL BE LOCATED AT LEAST 16" (406mm) FROM ANY OBSTRUCTION.
